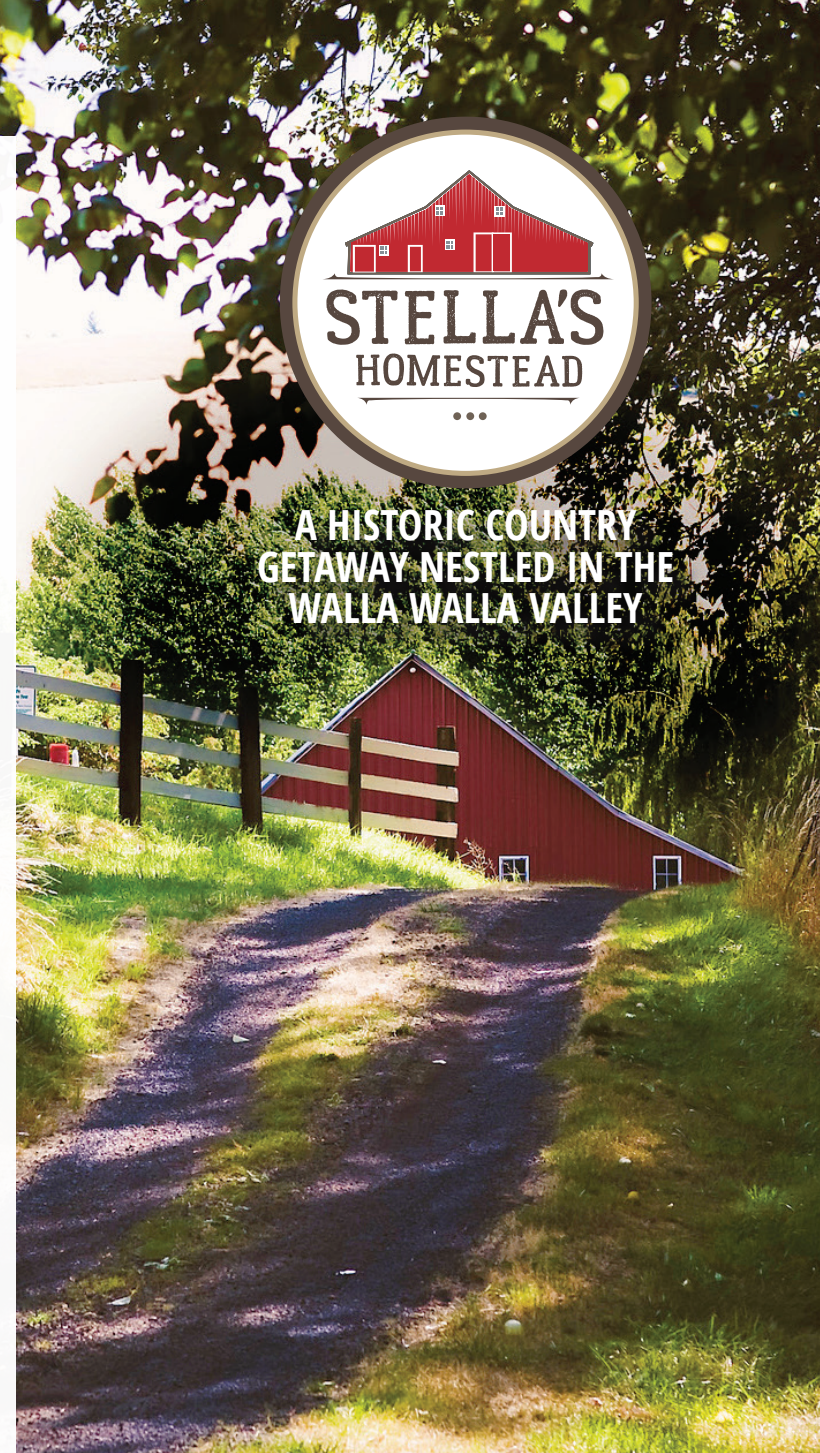

## Lodging Quarters

**LA CASITA** is located in Jim's Park, this charming, tiny, one-room lodge on wheels is called La Casita. Suited for two-three guests, it has a mini-kitchen and shower/toilet combo and is located adjacent to the South Fork Coppei Creek. Relax along "Coppei Beach" while gazing at the stars and warming up at the fire pit nearby. Kid and pet friendly.

**STELLA'S SHED** is another option suitable for up to six guests with a shower/toilet combo and vintage kitchen. Situated on one side by the South Fork Coppei Creek and the other side by a wide green pasture and pine forest, Stella's Shed provides ample space for kids and pets of all ages.



### CALICO'S CHICKEN HOUSE

sleeps three-four guests and once housed chickens and farming supplies—and the most famous farm cat of all, Calico aka "Farm Boss." While she still rules the roost, these quarters accommodate your

every creature comfort for short- and long-term stays. Calico's Chicken House is kid and pet friendly.

**THE SHOP** is the newest addition to Stella's Homestead and brings the total homestead accommodations to 24. Formerly a machine shop and a bunkhouse for wheat harvest crews in summer, The Shop caters to larger groups of up to 8 people. It features sturdy adult bunk beds, a large kitchen, double-showered bathroom, and living space indoors or outdoors for people to relax and entertain. Kid and pet friendly.

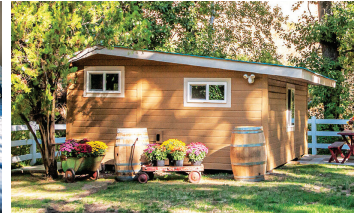

LA CASITA—SLEEPS 2-3



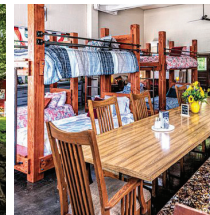
STELLA'S SHED—SLEEPS UP TO 6
